



Ventura Unit (547) 70%ers & 75%ers

The reports of big games ($\geq 70\%$ for the D22 Forum and $\geq 75\%$ for the ACBL Bulletin) are for club games only and other, specific restrictions apply. The Ventura Unit Club Manager reports only on Unit-owned games, i.e. those at Temple Beth Torah (TBT) on Tues/Wed/Thur, the Saturday game at the Pleasant Valley Recreation and Park District (PVRPD) and the Election Dinner game on a Saturday in January, whatever the location.

only Unit-owned games

Sunday Afternoon Bridge (the Townhouse in Ventura), the Ojai club(s), the Pleasant Valley club in Camarillo, and the two Camarillo Country Clubs (Las Posas and Spanish Hills) are responsible for reporting big games at their clubs.

The unsanctioned Workshop game on Tuesdays is never reported. Both point restricted games on Wednesday need to indicate whether it was the 49er or 1499er game. The Thursday 299er must be so annotated. The Saturday Election Dinner and Saturday "Theme" games must indicate if a big game was in the 499er section.

if not an Open game, list restriction(s)

As part of their directing regimen, Directors of Unit-owned games are required to place the gamefile in the CommonGame Dropbox in the GAMFILE directory. The person doing the monthly report will get the gamefiles for the month from that directory. If there was a 70% game, directors should e-mail the needed information to the Club Manager. For the Club Manager an additional check for $\geq 70\%$ games is to check the 70%ers page on the Unit web site. Unfortunately, it doesn't indicate any point restrictions for the event.

Reporting a 70% Game to the District 22 Forum

A single e-mail per month to Ken Monzingo (kenm@kenmonzingo.com) is done prior to the 4th of the next month. Joel Hirsch, Ken's predecessor, had some specific requirements:

Include: percent (to 2 dec. places), player 1 name "dash" player 2 name, name of club with restrictions if any, and date of game. Note, there is a comma after the 2nd player name and after the club name.

For example: 72.69% Sally Rea-Tim Rea, Ventura Unit Bridge Club 1499er, Jun 5

1. ACBL-sanctioned game.
2. Minimum of 20 hands.
3. Minimum of 5 tables (unless >26 bds).
4. Qualify in your strat only.

Although not requested, Ken arranges the entries from highest percentage at the top to lowest percentage at the bottom.

Reporting a 75% Game to the ACBL Bulletin

The ACBL web site page:

has the following instruction for reporting 75% (club) games to the Bulletin.

Big games must be reported to the Bridge Bulletin. These results are not automatically picked up from club files. The club director, manager or the players themselves may send a notice to biggames@acbl.org.

Requirements:

- 75% or higher scores in a club matchpoint game that is open or non-restricted. (For example, masterpoint-restricted games or country club games restricted by membership do not qualify. Nor do cruise games, sectional or regional games.)
- Five tables with at least 20 boards in play.
- Both players are paid ACBL members in good standing.
- A game recap must accompany the report — either via an attached text file or a permanent online link to where the results are posted.

I suggest following the Forum format and including:

percentage (to 2 decimal places), players' names, name of club, and date of game.

Although not required, the 6-digit club number would probably be helpful.
