



Bridge Director Tips

5 most common Director calls

Exposed Card	Auction [24] / Play [48-49]	[Law #]
Insufficient Bid	[27]	
Bid out of turn	[28-32]	
Lead out of turn	[24, 47-48, 53-56]	
Revoke	[61-64] established when either of offending side plays to next trick	

Some Directing Specifics

Lead Out of Turn	}	requirement to lead suit is one-time only
Opening Lead Out of Turn		

Minor Penalty Card

1. May play higher card if it's an honor (10 and up)
2. Don't have to lead suit

Dummy's Rights

Full rights at end of play

During play, only call Director if another player pointed out a possible irregularity

Everyone is responsible for dummy—not true, only the declaring side is responsible

If a defender has two or more penalty cards that can be legally played, declarer designates which is to be played!

most sites have a copy

Bridge Director's Companion— Sec II, Movements

most sites have a copy of small BDC

Laptop with ACBLscore

Portable printer except for Unit 547 & PV club

Seed money (\$1 bills & \$5 bills) except for PV club

Pen & Pencil

(≈ 30) travelers (in case Bridgemates fail)

Pick-up slips for last round (see above)

Latest convention card

Timer

Miscellaneous Items

2 boards/round: 15 minutes, else: (# bds) x 7 minutes

Fouled Bd: Bridge Director's Companion (BDC): II-88

call move as long as < ¼ tables still playing

Clean up starts in penultimate round or earlier
