

## Policies of Temple Beth Torah

Temple Beth Torah has various policies which we have agreed to adhere to. Remember, children are on the premises much of the year and their health and safety are paramount. The policies are:

1. Smoking is not permitted on the grounds — anywhere!
2. Pets are NOT allowed on the premises.
3. The Temple has a kosher food policy and no pork or shellfish products may be brought in. Also, mixing dairy and meat is not permitted.
4. Bridge players are to enter the parking lot from Foothill Road to avoid contributing to congestion at the entry door. Furthermore, we park in the BACK half of the lot as shown below. Drop-off and pick-up of children, and delivery of merchandise cause a great deal of congestion at the building entry area at certain times and we need to avoid that area both entering and exiting the lot.
