

MINUTES OF THE ACBL UNIT 547 BOARD MEETING

- I. President Gary Morgan called the meeting to order at 11:20 A.M.

Gary brought up changing some of the games and also changing the Sunday Swiss Teams game. Alan said that, in team events, he would like to go back to manual scoring instead of using the Bridgemates. He thinks that players should have time to compare scores between matches. Tom C. said he would bring the subject up at the next Directors' meeting. Also, regarding the lunch that is sold at the break, the Unit would substitute sandwiches for the "pinwheel" wraps.
- VI. The subject of changing the 199er game to a 299er game was brought up. The discussion was tabled at this time.
- VII. Discussion was held regarding the possible Unit upgrade of the dealing machine. Tom said that a new one would cost between \$4,000.00 and \$4,500.00. No decision was made at this time.
- VIII. Gary adjourned the meeting at 12:16 P.M. The next board meeting will be on June 5 at 11:15 A.M.
